The Event

Based in Olds, AB Legacy Land Trust Society engages with private landowners to conserve land with significant ecological, agricultural and heritage values.

As part of that engagement, Legacy invites you to discover one of these special places for yourself.

Nicknamed P3, **Paint, Pen & Pixels is a rich and rare opportunity**—to spend a day on privately conserved land creating your impressions of a memorable landscape.

The Land

A river meanders through this rural conservation property. Its **140 acres feature diverse and thriving ecosystems**—from riparian areas to forest to pasture, even a small orchard. Because of its special significance, it has been **certified as an Ecological Gift** by Environment and Climate Change Canada.

A previous P3 participant described it this way:

The Application

This P3 event takes place **Wednesday, May 29, 2024**. (In case of poor weather the alternate day is Saturday, June 1, 2024.) The land is in Mountain View County.

Selection of participants is based on the application. Creators in any media may apply.
